

Sutton Park Primary Uniform

Dear Parents and Carers,

The launch of our new school uniform earlier this academic year was a big success and it was wonderful to see the children looking so smart, representing our new school name with pride. We have been in a transition period since December, where elements of the old Banners Gate uniform (e.g. PE kits and blue polo shirts) were still able to be worn. This decision was made to avoid unnecessary waste and expense as they had been purchased only a few months before conversion.

As we look ahead to September, there have been some questions and queries so I wanted to take the opportunity to write to you and clarify uniform expectations.

From **September 2020**, the compulsory school uniform will be as follows:

- Sutton Park Primary sweatshirt/cardigan (with SP logo, no plain sweatshirts/cardigans)
- White polo shirt (SP logo embroidered is preferred)
- Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore
- Grey tights/socks
- Black school shoes

During the summer months, girls are also able to wear burgundy summer dresses if they prefer.

For PE, the compulsory uniform will be:

- Burgundy sports t-shirt (must have SP logo)
- Black shorts (shorts with SP logo are available and preferred)
- Black PE pumps/trainers for outdoors

All PE t-shirts and sweatshirts/cardigans worn should be embroidered with the school logo, not plain. Uniform plays a significant role in the appearance and first-impressions of our school. It also sets the tone for attitudes and behaviour so it is extremely important that pupils look smart and abide by the uniform policy. We want our pupils to wear their uniform with pride every day; showing they are happy to belong to our school community
