Our 'best seat in the house' assembly will return next week!

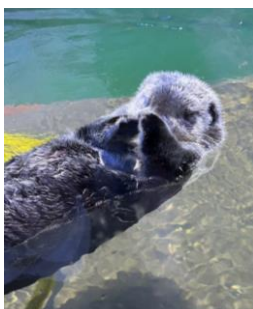
Congratulations to Kairo!
